Core Benefits are those services and access points that we guarantee to all residents of Darke, Miami & Shelby Counties. These services are mandated by ORC Ch. 340, serve our priority population and assist in reducing inpatient hospitalization.

CORE Benefits are guaranteed all residents of Darke, Miami and Shelby County regardless of their ability to pay:

- Pharmacy
- Assessment

- Treatment for alcoholism & other addictions
- Medicaid Match
